Tuesday February 13th Shrove Tuesday (Pancake Tuesday)





Shrove Tuesday occurs the day before Ash Wednesday (the first day of **Lent**). The date can range from as early as February 3 to as late as March 9. It is preceded by Shrove Monday and marks the end of Shrovetide, also known as the Pre-Lenten Season. This year, Shrove Tuesday is on *Tuesday, February 13th, 2024.*

Shrove Tuesday is precisely 47 days before **Easter** Sunday, a movable feast based on the computus calculation that determines

the yearly date of Easter.
